Congratulations! We are very excited about our Graduation Ceremony. I have listed a few quick reminders below:

Please make sure our seniors are dressed appropriately. Please do not forget your cap, gown, and tassel. Don't laugh...it has happened before. Seniors need to arrive on time...don't be late! Be careful as you enter Merriweather... the school holding the graduation ceremony before us has assured me that they will be done well before we arrive, but there still might be some traffic.

During the ceremony, please help us to recognize the accomplishments of each graduate by not being overly noisy as we read names. We know that this is a wonderful celebration and would hate it to be ruined for a family because they could not hear their graduate's name being read... I am sure that nobody wants that to happen to them...

As we know that this is an exciting and wonderful experience, we know that people want to celebrate. However, we do not want to disrespect others at this ceremony by wearing anything inappropriate or acting out in some way that dishonors our school or community. As much as I also want to celebrate with our students, I have explained to them that it is also my job to ensure the dignity of this special occasion. In accordance with school system procedures, please understand that we must refrain from beach balls, air horns, or anything else that detracts from this special event. Once again ... Congratulations to the Class of 2017!

## **Graduation Instructions**

- 1. You do not have to participate in the graduation ceremony in order to receive a diploma. **Parents must submit a** written request (email is fine) for non-participation to Mr. Saunderson by Friday, May 5, 2017.
- 2. Although participation in the graduation ceremony is voluntary, **attendance at all graduation rehearsals is mandatory in order to participate in the ceremony.** Be on time and stay for the full time. Perfect practice makes a perfect ceremony.
- 3. Caps and Gowns are required attire for the Graduation Ceremony and the Class Picture.
  - a. Seniors should wear their caps straight on their heads with the deep part at the back and the tassel over the left temple. Some of the caps will not fit easily with all present hair fashions. Adjust your hair fashion accordingly.
  - b. Females should wear a dress or blouse with skirt/pants and dress shoes. No flip-flops. Avoid large earrings and bracelets.
  - c. Males should wear white shirts or light colored collared shirts, dark neckties, dress pants, dark shoes, and dark socks. No sneakers, tennis shoes, boots, flip-flops or other casual footwear will be allowed. All shirts are to be buttoned and collars inside the gown.
  - d. When you receive your cap and gown, hang it up! Wrinkles do not come out when the gowns stay in the bags. **Do not iron your gown.**

- 4. During the ceremony:
  - a. When crossing the stage walk briskly.
  - b. Posture: straight heads up proud appearance smile show a sense of pride.
  - c. Spacing: 6 to 8 feet while walking.
  - d. Stand for the National Anthem. Gentlemen remove their caps.
- 5. All Howard County School System policies and school rules will remain in effect and will be enforced. Please do not jeopardize your privilege of participating in Graduation. Listen! Pay attention! If you do not cooperate during practices, you will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- 6. There will be a professional photographer photographing each graduate as their diploma is awarded. There will also be a professional videographer. Information and order forms will be available at graduation practices.
