KEY ACTION STEPS

AP ACTION STEPS:

- In order to impact AP performance for all students, all teachers will infuse AP style lessons, assignments, and standards into their curriculum.
- In order to impact AP performance for all students, administrative team members and Instructional Team Leaders will participate in curriculum and instruction meetings that focus on Understanding By Design and common assessments.
- In order to impact AP performance for all students, administrative team and Student Services will mentor students starting with our ninth graders and host family education evenings to promote students to enroll in advanced courses and register for AP exams. Student Services will use PSAT data, student schedules, and transcripts to strategically recommend and encourage a rigorous schedule for all students. Intervention and enrichment sessions such as Academic Success Night, AP Bootcamp, AP Mock Exams, and Reservoir Scholars will provide opportunities for students to prepare for AP exams, provide study skill strategies, and reinforce techniques for success on AP exams.

SAT ACTION STEPS:

- In order to impact SAT performance for all students, all staff and all departments will drive
 instruction by infusing and embedding SAT, AP, and PARCC style common assessments and
 common rubrics. Departments will develop and implement a long range model to support SAT
 style questions and skills derived from our monthly Professional Learning series.
- In order to impact SAT performance for all students, student Services Team and Administrative Team will use SAT Counselor Report to identify students who have/have not registered for the SAT on a monthly basis. Based on the report, Student Services will strategically encourage students to retake/register for the SAT as well as participate in preparation courses and SAT help sessions that include: SAT class during the day, after school SAT class, SAT/AP bootcamps, and additional resources. Student Services Team will coordinate information sessions to promote the SAT and ACT for students and parents to provide topics such as the right time to take the SAT.
- In order to impact SAT performance for all students, staff will create and run SAT prep and skill sessions during weekly Gator Time. Students will be strategically invited to attend sessions based on data from classroom teachers. Student Services will encourage students to attend and use PSAT data and quarterly grades as a reference.
